D.A. Graduation Requirements that you must keep in mind when registering for classes: Bible – 1 credit for each year enrolled; Language Arts - 4 cr.; Social Studies – 3 cr. (must include US History II); Science - 2 cr.; Math - 2 cr.; Foreign Language - 2 cr.; P.E. - 1 cr.; Health - .5 cr.; Electives – 7.5 cr. which must include .5 Computer credit starting with the Class of 2010 (students may test out of this requirement; see course descriptions for more information).
